Nepal – the Country





The geographical disadvantage of Nepal is a big constraint for the country's economic development, but the Himalayan range provides great tourism attractions in addition to the rich cultural heritage in the country

Note: the red dots roughly mark the locations of the four UNESCO world heritage sites

A country with rich cultures, exotic traditions and festivals

- A population of 30 million: 80% Hinduism and 10% Buddhism
- About 60 ethnic groups speaking 70 different languages



Climate

- Influenced by maritime and continental factors
- Has four distinct seasons
 - Spring (Mar to May): warm with rain showers; max.
 22°C
 - Summer (Jun to Aug): monsoon season; max. 30°C or more; hills are lush and green; trekking is difficult and uncomfortable
 - Autumn (Sep to Nov): cool with clear skies; max.
 25°C; most popular season for trekking
 - Winter (Dec to Feb): cold (could be below 0°C at night and 20°C at daytime; mountains covered with snow

- Kathmandu Valley: 7 cultural heritage sites counted together
- Lumbini: the birthplace of Lord Buddha
- Chitwan National Park: wildlife
- Sagarmatha National Park: Mt Everest

- Patan Dubar Square

- Boudhanath Stupa

- Changu Narayan Temple

Lumbini

- Birthplace of the Lord Buddha, Siddhartha Gautama
- Has a number of temples, many moments, monasteries and a museum
- Buddhist pilgrimage site



Chitwan National Park

- Dense forests and grassy plains
- Home to rare mammals such as one-horned rhinos and Bengal tigers and numerous bird species
- Activities:
 - Canoe ride in Rapti River to discover crocodiles, otters, water birds, etc.
 - Jeep safari in the forests to spot wildlife
 - Elephant ride in the forests
 - Bird watching

Sagarmatha National Park

- World's highest peaks
 - Mt Everest (8,848m)
 - Seven other peaks over 6,000m (Lhotse, Cho Oyu, Pumori, Ama Dablam, Thamerku, Kwangde, Kangtaiga and Gyachyung Kang)
- Home to several rare species (snow leopard, red panda, dazzling pheasants)
- Dramatic beauty of mountains, glaciers and deep valleys
